Woodstock offers three strong diploma programs. As an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, Woodstock offers both the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) and Diploma Programme (DP). We also offer a standalone Woodstock Diploma (U.S. High School Diploma) along with a Woodstock Diploma and Advanced Placement (APs) pathway. Students complete the IB MYP in Grade 10, while ABRSM music exams are optional.

The Class of 2024 will complete the IBDP at Woodstock while also being awarded the US high school diploma at the same time and receiving four years of outdoor education through the weeklong Activity Week.




