Woodstock School offers three strong diploma programmes. As an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, we offer both the IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) and Diploma Programme (DP). Additionally, we offer both the standalone **Woodstock Diploma** and the **Woodstock Diploma with a Mastery Pathway**. The Mastery pathway is designed for students with a passion for and commitment to a specific field of study. Students complete the IB MYP in Grade 10. ABRSM music exams are optional, and all the students participate in Outdoor Education through the annual week-long Activity Week.

This year, we introduced four credit-bearing **electives** to our students, empowering them to explore passions and develop unique skill sets, aligning with our commitment to creating responsible global citizens. **Electives offered are:** Traditions of Indian Origin, Sacred Spaces & Interfaith Dialogue, Garhwal History, and Music Production & Sound Design.

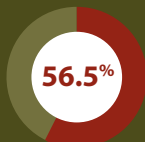

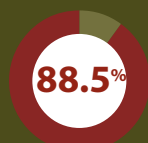
2025 IBDP Results

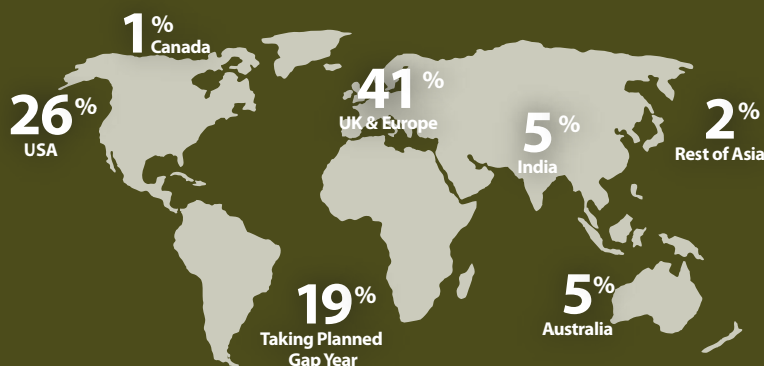
